Instructions for completing Scholarship Application

Print name and Club. Complete name of event that you are wanting the scholarship for (4-H Camp, Discovery Days...)

Each event can only be used once. For example, judging at Club Days could not be used in both # 5 and #7. All events must have taken place in the last 12 months.

- 1. Check the blank and fill in the number of meetings attended and how many were held. You may need to contact your club secretary.
- 2. Check the blank and fill in the type of presentation (project, illustrated talk, demonstration, public speaking...), the date and name of talk.
- 3. Check the blank and write in your club leaders name.
- 4. Check the blank and write down the name of the committee: finance, educational trip, booth & banner, special events, club days...
- 5. Check the blank and list the type of judging (FCS, Livestock, Photography, Crop, Horticulture...) and list the date or event name (such as Club Days.)
- 6. Check the blank and name the project such as Loaves and Fishes, Scottish Festival, Red Kettle, Operation Christmas Child, Recycle It...)
- 7. Check the blank and describe event: gave a talk, door superintendent, pickle power, gavel games...
- 8. Check blank and name exhibit such as cookies to 4-H Fair, rabbit to County Fair...
- 9. Check blank and describe participation such as worked at concession stand, barnyard Olympics, assistant superintendent for foods...
- 10. Check blank and list and describe such as: attended 4-H Family Fun at YMCA, went to county achievement banquet, went on club educational tour to the Salt Mine, went to Cloverbud workshop, showed dog in Spring 4-H Dog show.

Scholarship is \$40 or $\frac{1}{2}$ of the registration fee - whichever is less.
